DUE BY JUNE 12

- A brief description/PDF of each research work and details of the medical conference where the work first appeared: email to mjstrobela@apfed.org.
- APFED will make every effort to confirm acceptance within 24 hours.

DUE BY JUNE 19

- **Final file submissions.**
 - Provide APFED with the PDF of the work that you would like displayed to conference attendee and a recorded, lay summary of the work (up to 10 minutes, MP4 file)
- The recordings should depict your poster (e.g., using the "screenshare" feature) and contain a voice over of describing the work in a lay-friendly fashion. You may use the recording platform of your choice, or APFED can assist.
